

Ordinance 2016 –1
Implementation Standards for 2017

Fees:

The fee structure is the same as the prior licensing system. Calculate your license fee based on an annual fee of \$50.00 for up to the first three vehicles (if you are operating one, two, or three vehicles, the cost is \$50.00). Each additional vehicle is \$10.00 (for example, if you are operating four vehicles, the cost is \$60.00).

PAYT (Volume Based Disposal)

All residential customers (residential structures with not more than two dwelling units) in the unincorporated county will receive PAYT waste disposal pricing.

Area of the county subject to unlimited recycling:

See the map of Boulder County on the reverse side.

The area of the unincorporated county east of Hwy 93 and Hwy 36, the Eldorado Springs community and Lake of Pines and Crestview neighborhoods will receive unlimited recycling

Organics Collections:

Food waste and yard waste collection will be collected east of 39th St and south of Nelson Rd., north of the city of Boulder

Food waste and yard waste collection will be collected east of Hwy 93 south of the city of Boulder.

Yard waste only will be collected west of 39th St and south of Nelson Rd. and will also include Lake of the Pines and Crestview Estates, north of the city of Boulder and the Eldorado Springs community west of Hwy 93 south of the city of Boulder.

Materials to be collected as recyclables:

Materials shall be collected in single stream form from residential properties covered by the ordinance.


Single stream materials shall include:

Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, corrugated cardboard, Kraft bags (brown grocery bags), paperboard (chipboard), mail, office paper, phone books, glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans and foil, steel/tin cans, empty aerosol cans, plastic bottles, jugs, tubs and jars with a #1-#7 on the bottom.

It is now okay to recycle plastic caps from plastic bottles and jugs as long as they are attached to the container and as long as the plastic bottle or jug is empty.

Please NO plastic caps or lids of ANY kind on glass bottles and jars.

Please NO loose plastic caps or lids or flat lids on plastic tubs.




Jefferson County
