**II. Coordinator and Partner Updates**

General updates:

- MS4 Permit discussion
  - Adjudication deadline is May 13, 2016.
  - Irrigation ditches – application supplement due January 1, 2017. New requirement.
  - Adjacent to state waters language still contained in language.
  - Construction inspection types – various.
  - Post-construction exclusions/flow diagram need? The group showed interest in pursuing this.
  - Pesticides – additional outreach language added since last draft.
  - PDD (SOPs and ordinances update too) – completed January 1, 2019
    - Website reference for review of PDD by public requirement
    - Priority areas and centralize record keeping in IDDE Plan
  - Education (including nutrients) – begin July 1, 2018. It should be noted the requirements address both passive and active outreach.
  - PACE
    - Business outreach – begin July 1, 2018.
    - Municipal support (one visit/one training (including IDDE) is this adequate for the Partners?
  - Annual report - tracking exemptions will be necessary.
  - Ag waste exemption is gone.
  - Industrial reporting requirement is gone.
  - Bulk storage defined at 55 gallons – completed by July 1, 2021.
  - Joint efforts i.e. products – the group discussed needing support with the PDD and tracking deadlines and a permit requirements' gap tool.
  - Water Quality Control Division representatives attended a meeting with the Colorado Stormwater Council and indicated that there would be a Q&A

response on the Division's website addressing questions surrounding the MS4 permit.

- The annual report format should be out the end of the summer.
- May 10 watershed meeting – is scheduled. Report is not complete Jane Clary is waiting on final fact sheet input and Timberline Aquatics data.
- Left Hand data report – post on KICP watershed web page.
- Watershed wish list review – to be discussed at watershed meeting.
- KICP Strategy document which the IGA references has been update and is on the KICP password protected section.
- Ditch riders concerns – Janice Lopitz met with a few ditch representatives and discussed both quality and quantity as it relates to urban run-off.
- ERO SEMSWA – Scott Coulson and Janice Lopitz will attend on June 15<sup>th</sup>.
- CIP training – Janice Lopitz will attend on May 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Boulder Newcomers – Janice Lopitz will present to their luncheon on KICP.
- COCO – Janice Lopitz will sit on the board.
- Erin Dodge mentioned that Captain Jack mine is receiving attention from EPA.
- The Construction Training survey conducted by CDPHE does not have any follow up. 10% of all construction sites will be visited by CDPHE.
