### **II. Coordinator and Partner Updates**

General updates:

- Permit compliance approach - data gap tool, PDD and timeline have been distributed.
- Post-Construction Design Standard for Equivalent Area – Colorado Stormwater Council (CSC) project – moving forward and deliverables may include potential permit language.
- Natural Capital Resource Assessment – South Platte Basin/Urban Waters Partners <https://www.epa.gov/urbanwaterspartners/south-platte-natural-capital-project>, Denvercentric, economics around green ‘infrastructure’, mapping tools
- Urban Water Cycle Program – CSC will sponsor – bike field trip around Denver watershed.
- CIP trainings – UDFCD October 25th and Thornton November 15<sup>th</sup> – Janice Lopitz will forward email invitation.
- Permit fees - July 2017 30% increase – in statue, 50% cash/50% general fund
- Shape files shared with CDOT – Memo maybe authored and forwarded in the near future explaining CDOT’s goals.
- CSU Stormwater Center – Post-construction MS4 compliance training (who is the audience) and inspection training for BMPs just after construction to ensure they are built adequately maybe be developed as new courses.
- 2016 Watershed Monitoring Report follow ups:
  - Lab manager’s meeting – it was requested that the existing issues and goals of the meeting be clearly stated to the managers.
  - Algae/Chlorophyll-a monitoring

- 2 above 2 below WWTP 3x/year limit July1- Sept 30 \$25.00/sample
      - The City of Boulder offered to train anyone interested.
  - Atmospheric nitrogen – USGS approached both KICP and BCPH ask for support of approximately 7K/year to fund an atmospheric nitrogen study. Though the Partners were interested in the data they determined they were not in position to fund the project. Janice Lopitz will follow up with Greg Wetherbee of USGS about a presentation in the future.
- Continue Watershed Group discussion:
  - County survey for *All Things Water* progress – Janice Lopitz sent KICP Plan and PDD template to the Boulder County Sustainability office as they review the County water programs.
  - City of Boulder’s thoughts – Bret Linenfelser indicated that it is time to facilitate the larger watershed discussion. Maybe contract with a consultant to determine the scope of the group. Stormwater a subgroup of the larger picture.
  - The group discussed bringing forth their communities’ needs at the October meeting and discussing going forward in 2017.
  - The contingency monies can fund the effort.
  - Janice Lopitz will work to identify watershed experts.
- Creek Neighbor Coalition RFP has been released. Janice Lopitz will keep tabs on outcome/final product.
- KIC-Net program of Earthforce– Janice Lopitz shared that this group might be able to supply school/committee outreach support.
- Ocean Ranger training – Fifteen individuals were trained and Janice Lopitz attended and supported the stormwater message.
