



The financial guidelines for eligibility for Nurse-Family Partnership are based upon the annual Health and Human Services Poverty Guidelines updated and published by the federal registry each year. Please use the guidelines below for referrals.

### Federal Poverty Guidelines

2	\$16,020	\$32,040

8	\$40,890	\$81,780
For each additional person, add	\$4,160	\$8,320

*When calculating family size, always include the woman and the number of babies she expects to have or has had —a woman with a single child has a family size of 2; a woman with twins has a family size of 3; etc.*
