

Regional Transit Service

Niwot is served by three bus routes:

- BOLT- Service along Diagonal Highway between Longmont and Boulder
- J- Service along Diagonal Highway between Longmont and South Boulder
- L/LX/LSX- Service between Longmont & Denver

Niwot is served by two Park-n-Rides:

- Niwot Park-n-Ride, Niwot Rd & SH 119 (BOLT & J)
- US 287/ Niwot Park-n-Ride, Niwot Rd & US 287 (L/LX/LSX)






Bicycle Safety- Rules of the Road

Never ride against traffic

Always ride with the flow of traffic.



A front headlight (visible at a distance of at least 500 ft.) and both side and rear reflectors are required under Colorado law. (42-4-204, 42-4-221). A red blinky light is a bright idea too.

Use hand signals

BE CAUTIOUS WHEN RIDING TWO ABBREAST

Two bicyclists may ride side-by-side, but "shall not impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic" (42-4-1412(6)(a)(b)). When there is a car behind you, or you are traveling around a blind curve, transition to single file riding. Remember, 'courtesy is contagious'.

The Niwot Community

Niwot History

Niwot was named for Chief Niwot, an Arapaho leader, whose people were hunting and fishing along the Front Range when the first gold miners arrived here in 1858. The original townsite was platted on both sides of what is now the Diagonal Highway, the main route between Boulder and Longmont.

Niwot's commercial district of the 1880s lay on the west side of the track near the depot, while most of the town's residents lived on the east side. Railroad activity continued to revolve around the depot, but by the turn of the century, stores and services also began to appear across the track as well.

All of the buildings west of the track have since burned, been torn down, or were moved in 1959 and 1960 to make room for the Longmont Diagonal. Niwot's "Old Town" Historic District represents a significant collection of buildings dating from the early 1900s, typical of Boulder County's early agricultural communities.



Transit + Bicycling

Bike-n-Ride



1. Squeeze handle to release the rack



2. Lower the rack



3. Place front wheel on side labeled "front wheel"



4. Pull support arm over the wheel

- Signal to bus driver that you are loading your bike.
- You must be able to lift your bike and place it on the rack yourself.

- Stay near the front of the bus and watch your bike to ensure its safety.
- Exit the front door and remind the driver you are removing your bike.

- If you are the last person to unload your bike, return rack to its upright position.

RTD is not responsible for lost or stolen bikes or damage to bikes due to improper loading.

Bus-then-Bike Shelters

Consider commuting by bus and using a bicycle to complete the last mile of your commute. You can leave your bicycle overnight in one of Boulder County's Bus-then-Bike Shelters. For a free access card, apply online at busthenbike.com.

- 8th & Coffman, central Longmont
- Table Mesa Park-n-Ride, south Boulder
- 30th & Diagonal Highway, north Boulder (Fall 2014)
- 14th & Walnut, central Boulder (Fall 2014)
