


# Thermometer Calibration Log

Calibrate all thermometers at least once a week and when dropped



## How to Calibrate a Thermometer

1. Fill a glass with ice (crushed is best) and add a little water.
2. Submerge thermometer stem.
3. Wait a minute for temperature to adjust.
4. If thermometer does not read 32°F when in the ice water, calibrate:
  - a. If dial- use a wrench to turn the nut under the dial face until the thermometer reads 32°F
  - b. If digital- see manufacturer instructions or send it to the manufacturer to calibrate

Note: Keep the thermometer in the water when calibrating

Replace thermometers if they cannot be accurately calibrated
