ACT NOW!

- The District Attorney's Office has a free, confidential service in Spanish. You can call, any time. You do not have to give your personal information if you are not comfortable with this. Call **303-441-3700**, between 8am and 5 pm.
- We have Spanish wage demand forms, and can help with completing a formal wage demand to your employer.
- You will be given advice about whether it is appropriate to file a complaint with the Department of Labor, or to file in Small Claims Court.
- The District Attorney's office has investigators who will work with the Department of Labor on your case if needed.
- You can be referred to attorneys who deal with civil wage claims, and agencies which can help you, often at little or no cost.
- The District Attorney's Office will review all complaints to decide when criminal action is appropriate.
