RESTRICTIONS:

- 1. The move shall be made only during daylight hours, and shall not be made on Saturday after 12 Noon, on Sunday, or on New Year's Day, Christmas, Thanksgiving, Memorial Day, Independence Day or Labor Day.
2. Safety measures shall be carried out, as checked:
[ ] Red Flags [ ] Pilot Cars [ ] Wide Load Signs [ ] Flagmen Other \_\_\_\_\_
3. The load shall be loaded so as to present a minimum hazard to traffic.
4. In case of widths in excess of 18', the Boulder County Sheriff's Office shall be notified one day in advance of the route and time of move.
5. Loads in excess of 16' in height shall require adequate advance notice to all public utilities which may have overhead facilities along the route.
6. The permittee shall make the move with the least possible hazard to the safety and convenience of the public, traffic and property owners along the route.
7. The permittee shall recognize and hold harmless the County of Boulder and all employees or officers of the County of Boulder from any responsibility for damage or injury to any persons or public or private property, roads, structures and any and all appurtenances within the County road right-of-way that may be caused by the movement as granted by this permit.
8. The permittee shall be solely responsible for and make prompt and sufficient payment for all and any damages or injury caused by the movement as granted by this permit.
9. Load limits on bridges shall not be exceeded.
10. If the load can be broken down to legal size and/or weight, no permit shall be issued. Permits are for indivisible loads only.
11. This permit shall be carried in the vehicle described hereon at all times during the move, and shall be surrendered for inspection upon demand.
12. This permit is granted only for this roads directly under the jurisdiction of the County of Boulder, and does not include roads under the jurisdiction of any incorporated city or the Colorado Department of Highways.
13. This permit may be revoked at any time.
14. The permittee shall pay, upon issuance of this permit, the fee of \$25.00 plus any damage deposit as detailed below for the first vehicle load, plus \$20.00 for each additional vehicle load. The fee may be waived for governmental agencies.

PERMIT INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. A PERMIT IS REQUIRED IF THE SIZE OR WEIGHT OF THE EQUIPMENT OR LOAD EXCEEDS THE FOLLOWING:

Table with 4 columns: Length, Width, Weight, and vehicle type. Includes rows for Single Vehicle, Comb. Of Vehicles, and All Others.

Weight for combination of vehicles such as semi tractor and trailer:

Table with 6 columns: Wheelbase, Weight, Wheelbase, Weight, Wheelbase, Weight. Lists weight limits for various wheelbase lengths.

- 2. OVER-LENGTH, OVER-HEIGHT, OVER-WIDTH, AND/OR OVERWEIGHT MAY ALL BE WRITTEN ON THE SAME PERMIT.
3. THE DAMAGE DEPOSIT, WHICH IS REQUIRED ON EXTREMELY SIDE LOADS, SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:
At Least 15' But Less Than 20' \$25.00 At Least 25' But Less Than 30' \$75.00
At Least 20' But Less Than 25' \$50.00 30' Or Wider \$100.00
THE DEPOSIT, LESS SUFFICIENT AMOUNT TO COVER ANY DAMAGES, SHALL BE RETURNED TO PERMITTEE AFTER INSPECTION OF ROUTE. PROVIDED FURTHER, HOWEVER, THAT SHOULD ANY DAMAGES BE SUSTAINED OR INFLICTED IN AN AMOUNT GREATER THAN THE DEPOSIT, THE PERMITTEE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL OF SAID DAMAGES, LESS THE ENTIRE DEPOSIT.
4. PERMITS SHOULD BE ISSUED FOR A PERIOD SUFFICIENT FOR THE MOVE, WITH A NORMAL LIMITATION OF TWO WEEKS, EXCEPT FOR HEAVY CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT (30 DAYS), COMMERCIAL COMBINING AND FARM EQUIPMENT DELIVERY BY DEALERS (90).
5. PERMITS SHOULD BE WRITTEN ONLY FOR THE ACTUAL ROUTES USED, EXCEPT FOR HEAVY CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT AND COMMERCIAL COMBINING AND FARM EQUIPMENT DELIVERY BY DEALERS (COUNTY-WIDE).
