Dear Ms. McRedmond:

With reference to your Notice of Pending Survey dated October 13, 2017, Boulder County objects to boundary survey work on its property for Crestone Peak Resources because the properties identified have not been approved for oil and gas facility work by Boulder County or by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission. At such time as boundary surveys would be appropriately conducted, Boulder County would require that such work be done without the use of drones. The 10:13-R and 36:23-C blocks listed in your letter contain active bald eagle nests that will be disturbed by any unnecessary activity within half a mile and must be avoided during the breeding season. Moreover, Boulder County would request notification of actual times of entry onto its properties at least 24 hours prior to such entry and may have additional limitations at that time to protect wildlife, environmental and agricultural resources and activities.
