- 2. Comply with all requirements of the permit:
- 3. Immediately cease land-disturbing activities upon receipt of a written Stop Work Order from an authorized representative of the County. A Stop Work Order shall be issued and this Permit revoked if the Permittees are not in compliance with the SWQP or if the Permittees fail to take corrective action within the time specified on the written notification of such non-compliance;
- 4. Understand that in addition to other remedies, a violation of this SWQP shall constitute a violation of the County's Ordinance; and
- 5. Understand any approval obtained from the County does not obviate your need to comply with the requirements of the State of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Colorado Discharge Permit System, General Permit, and Sections 7 and 9 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, 16 U.S.C. 1531, et seq., as amended, or with any other applicable federal, state, local laws, or regulations.
