“Fresh Start” Program Eligibility

Only certain types of cases are eligible to benefit from the “Fresh Start” program.

- A. If you **have not** yet pleaded guilty, you **may be** eligible if:
- ✓ You were charged with misdemeanor offenses only (this includes an arrest for felony charges where only misdemeanor charges were filed), and
 - ✓ Those misdemeanor charges are NOT:
 - Driving Under the Influence or Driving While Ability Impaired,
 - Assault in the Third Degree,
 - A crime of domestic violence, or
 - Child Abuse.
- B. If you **have** pleaded guilty or were convicted, you **may be** eligible if:
1. You pleaded guilty to, or were convicted of, misdemeanor offenses only, and
 2. Those misdemeanor offenses are NOT:
 - a. Assault in the Third Degree,
 - b. A crime of domestic violence, or
 - c. Child Abuse.

Your case **does not** qualify if you are charged, pleaded guilty to, or were convicted of:

- Assault in the Third Degree,
- A crime of domestic violence, or
- Child Abuse.
