## Batteries: Keep 'em Out of the Bin!

**Billions of batteries are improperly disposed of each year – making their way to landfills or recycling facilities where they present harm to environments and people.**

**Instead of tossing batteries into your trash or recycle bins, take them to the Boulder County Hazardous Materials Management Facility, located at 1901c 63rd Street in Boulder.**

**Residential Drop-Off:** Wednesday – Saturday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., no appointment necessary. Free for all Boulder County, City and County of Broomfield, and Town of Erie residents.

**Business Drop-Off:** Tuesdays by appointment only. Disposal fees apply.

**PLEASE TAPE** all lithium batteries and any other battery over 9-volts with clear tape on the positive battery terminal to prevent a fire.
