Person-Centered Care for LGBT Older Adults



Project Visibility is a cultural responsiveness training for service providers and any interested party on the strengths and needs of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender Elders.

Trainings are tailored for the audience and typically include a locally-produced short film, a brief “basics” presentation, and interactive exercises.

LGBT elders are four times less likely to have children and are twice as likely to live alone, yet are **5 times less likely** to access senior services. In the absence of informed care and support, LGBT older adults are at higher risk for depression, substance abuse, unnecessary institutionalization and premature death (www.SAGEUSA.org).

The Boulder County Area Agency on Aging has been providing trainings for care providers of LGBT older adults since 2004, following extensive focus groups with area LGBT elders seeking “safe and friendly” providers who expressed fears that providers could be unwelcoming or even hostile.

This national award winning training has been featured at multiple conferences and continues to be in demand by those invested in culturally-informed client-centered services.

Project Visibility® LIVE Trainings:

This in-person training for managers and employees of nursing homes, assisted living residences, home care agencies, and other senior service providers (as well as friends and families of LGBT elders) builds on a 21-minute locally produced video while a PowerPoint guides discussion. An accompanying manual provides history, terminology, resources, and practical tips for culturally competent care and service. Free, customized, in-house trainings can be as short as 30 minutes or as long as 3 hours.
