1. Question: On the bid form, it calls out note 1 thru 4 for several bid items. Where do we find the notes?

ANSWER: The Notes were cut-off in the editing process, they are here to inform your bid and also included in the revised BID WORKSHEET TABLE attached in this Bid Addendum #1.

2. Question: The bid form call out Water Rights for the use of water for construction and warranty period. Can you give us more detail for this item?

ANSWER: This bid item #51 has been removed from the bid tab and the following bid items renumbered. A revised bid tab is included in this Bid Addendum #1. At the time it was inserted, Boulder County Parks & Open Space was intending to coordinate with the Contractor to lease the water for the project. With the removal of this pay item, the source of the water will become part of the overhead cost of the project. It is clear in the Construction Specifications, on page 77 in particular, that the Contractor is responsible for the provision of all construction period water and all warranty period water. This will likely involve formal lease agreements with, and payments to, other entities (which could include municipalities, ditch companies, water districts, or other identified source). The identified source of water and the associated water use accounting documentation will need to be reviewed by relevant parties including the BCPOS Water Resources Specialist.

A search of the word “water” in all BID documents and a careful review of all documents will help to provide relevant information associated with the use of water in the project.

This is also explained in the “Pre-Bid Meeting” video (link on this web page <https://www.bouldercounty.org/open-space/management/st-vrain-creek-restoration-reach-3-phase-2/>) and the presentation given by Audrey Butler, BCPOS Water Resources Specialist.

It is the Contractor’s responsibility to locate and purchase the water that will be needed for all water needs associated with the periods of project construction and project warranty. Means and methods will be the responsibility of the Contractor. Pumping of water from the creek or the use of water from the dewatering process for any project purpose is not allowed without legal purchase or lease of that water.

3. Question: Is there a complete oil specification regarding the biodegradable oil to be used in the equipment?

ANSWER: There are guidelines in the BID documents for what could be accepted and what will be rejected in the submittal documentation from the selected contractor, and a preferred base oil (search the term “hydraulic” in the documents), but no complete oil specification. The means and methods are the responsibility of the Contractor. There are many ways to meet this requirement depending on the equipment selected for use, the manufacturer of the equipment, the presence or details of the warranty on the equipment, and the availability of the hydraulic fluid among other factors.

Submittals sent to any other box will NOT be forwarded or accepted. This email box is only accessed on the due date of your questions or proposals. Please use the Delivery Receipt option to verify receipt of your email. It is the sole responsibility of the proposer to ensure their documents are received before the deadline specified above. Boulder County does not accept responsibility under any circumstance for delayed or failed email or mailed submittals.

All proposals must be received and time and date recorded at the purchasing email by the above due date and time. Sole responsibility rests with the Offeror to see that their bid is received on time at the stated location(s). Any bid received after due date and time will be returned to the bidder.
