Latex/Nitrile Gloves

Wear gloves when it's likely that contact with potentially infectious illnesses, such as COVID-19, potentially contaminated skin, contaminated clothing, or contaminated equipment could occur. **Note:** Gloves are not a substitute for hand hygiene. Wash hands before and after use, and change gloves after each use.
