<b>Grants</b>	LURA COVID-19 Small Business Microgrant Program for Businesses: Restaurants and other small businesses located within the Old Town Urban Renewal Area with up to 50 employees that did not receive a grant award through the City of Lafayette's COVID-19 Small Business Emergency Relief Grant Program may qualify for a grant for paying essential business operating expenses including business rent, utilities, insurance or other adaptations to address re-opening. Grant awards subject to availability of funds.
