Federal Mask Requirement

Persons must wear masks over the mouth and nose when traveling. On January 21, 2021, President Biden issued [Executive Order 13998](#), which requires masks on transit systems to mitigate the risk of COVID-19. To implement the presidential EO, on Friday, January 29, the CDC issued the [Requirement for Persons to Wear Masks While on Conveyances and at Transportation Hubs order](#), and on Sunday, January 31, the TSA issued [Security Directive 1582/84-21-01](#).

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Why Transportation Options are Key to Successful Vaccination

Mobility for All are responsible for ensuring that all county residents, including the most vulnerable, have access to reliable and affordable transportation.

Transportation is one of the largest obstacles in vaccinating vulnerable populations; therefore, the above transportation options aim to serve Boulder County residents regardless of financial status and/or access to private transportation. Boulder County’s multiple transportation options have made changes to their services to make vaccine trips a top priority.

Funding Transportation to Vaccine Sites

Because transportation can be financially prohibitive for many individuals, the above transportation resource inventory includes a wide variety of options, both functionally and financially. **In order to help overcome some financial challenges of these communities, it is important that local governments and organizations cover some or all of transportation costs to vaccine sites when possible.**

Distribution of the Transportation Plan Action Steps

This transportation plan will be distributed primarily in two broad categories, **Mobility for All outreach resources** and **Boulder County Public Health outreach resources**.

Mobility for All will promote and distribute this plan in multiple methods:

1. The plan will be included in both **Mobility for All's monthly newsletter** and the **Mobility for All Local Coordinating Council newsletter**.
2. **The plan will be distributed to all members of the Local Coordinating Council**, which includes both transportation and human service providers.
3. Mobility for All will share the plan with **Peak to Peak Housing** and **Human Service Alliance and HHS Local Area Collaboratives**.
4. Mobility for All will share **bilingual posts to their social media** channels promoting and directing people to the plan.
5. Mobility for All will create a **partner social media toolkit with bilingual content** to share with community stakeholders

Boulder County Public Health will promote and distribute this plan in multiple methods:

1. Boulder County Public Health will **post this plan to the [COVID-19 Vaccines](#) page on the county's website**.
2. The plan and partner social media toolkit will be distributed to **Boulder County and Municipal Communications Specialists**.
